

Tips for Recording Your Performance on Phones/Tablets!

- Background
 - Make sure it's professional, clean, and there's nothing distracting going on behind you
- Lighting
 - Use a well-lit room
 - Natural light is great, but make sure you're facing it and don't have it behind you, otherwise you'll be hard to see
 - Make sure it's bright enough that we can see you clearly on video!
- How to Get The Best Sound Quality
 - Make sure you're in a room by yourself and electronics are off/on silent
 - We suggest using the camera app that comes installed on your phone/tablet
- Camera Orientation
 - Students must use **LANDSCAPE** orientation
- Camera Angle
 - Make sure it's set up far enough away from you
 - The best angles are straight at you or looking down at you slightly, but avoid drastic angles!
 - Make sure you're centered in the video/in the frame
- Use Airplane Mode to make sure no notifications interrupt the recording process!
- What to wear
 - Dress professionally, like something you would want to wear for an audition
 - Make sure it's something your grandma would be okay seeing you in!
 - Avoid tank tops and crop tops
 - Make sure you look put together! If you're questioning whether it's professional or not, always go with an option that makes you feel comfortable
- How to share video
 - Email the video if it's under 20 MB, or share to the cloud if it's larger
